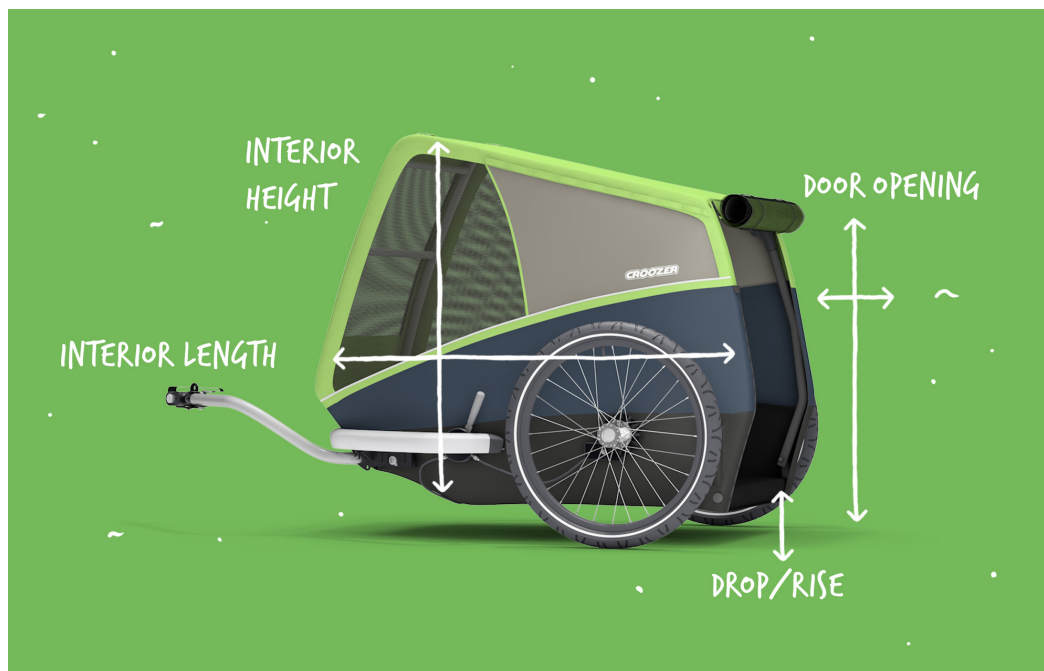


## WHICH DOG TRAILER FITS MY PET?

Our new Croozer trailer models, the Dog L, XL and XXL, are the first dog bike trailers **specially designed for large and heavy dogs**. Thanks to the low door, even **disabled** dogs can easily enter the trailer and enjoy stress-free outings with their owners. Below, we've listed a **variety of dog breeds as examples** to help you determine which of our bicycle trailers would be the right size for your four-legged friend.

Here, you can see the exact **dimensions of the three trailer models** so that you can measure your dog and decide which trailer offers the best fit:



### **Dimensions of the Dog L**

- Interior height: 62 cm
- Door opening: 32 x 53 cm
- Drop/rise: 14 cm
- Interior length: 75 cm
- Max load: 35 kg

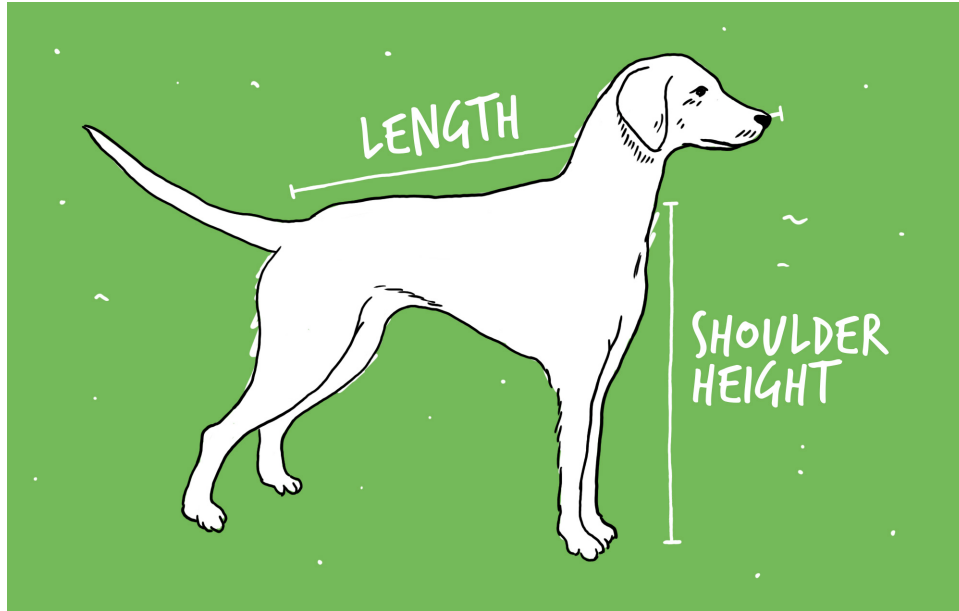
### **Dimensions of the Dog XL**

- Interior height: 77 cm
- Door opening: 46 x 63 cm
- Drop/rise: 14 cm
- Interior length: 90 cm
- Max load: 45 kg

### **Dimensions of the Dog XXL**

- Interior height: 87 cm
- Door opening: 46 x 73 cm
- Drop/rise: 14 cm
- Interior length: 100 cm
- Max load: 45 kg

You can **measure** your dog as follows to determine which of the Croozer dog bike trailers fits best to your pet:



### DOG BREEDS AS EXAMPLES



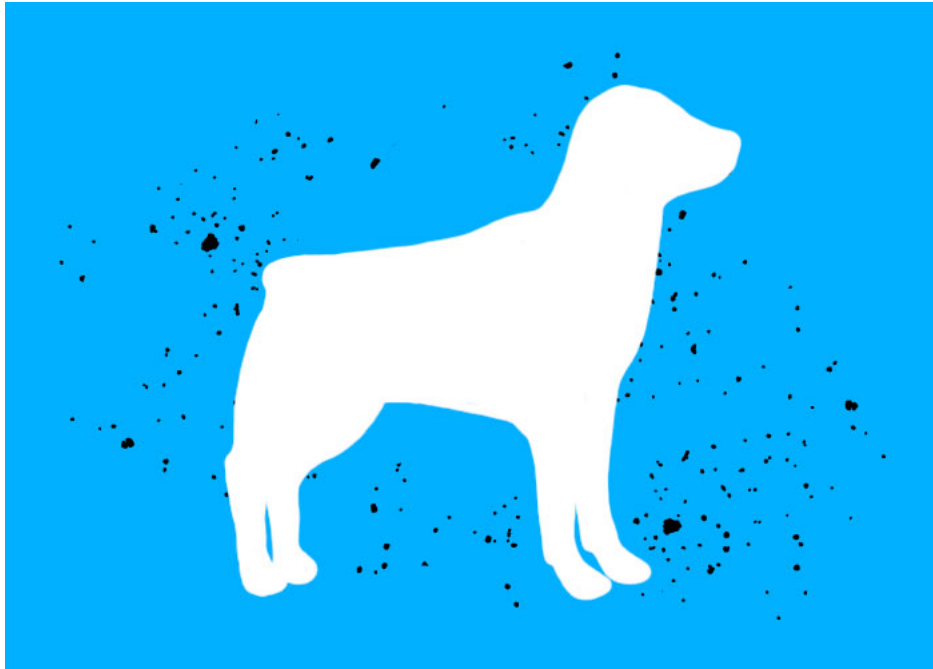
We want your dog to feel safe and comfortable in his bicycle trailer. Therefore, it is also important to make sure that the trailer is not too large for him. Here are a few examples of dog breeds that would be too small to ride comfortably in the new Croozer Dog trailers:

- Cavalier King Charles Spaniel
- Chihuahua
- Dachshund
- French Bulldog
- Havanese
- Jack Russell Terrier
- Yorkshire Terrier
- Miniature Schnauzer



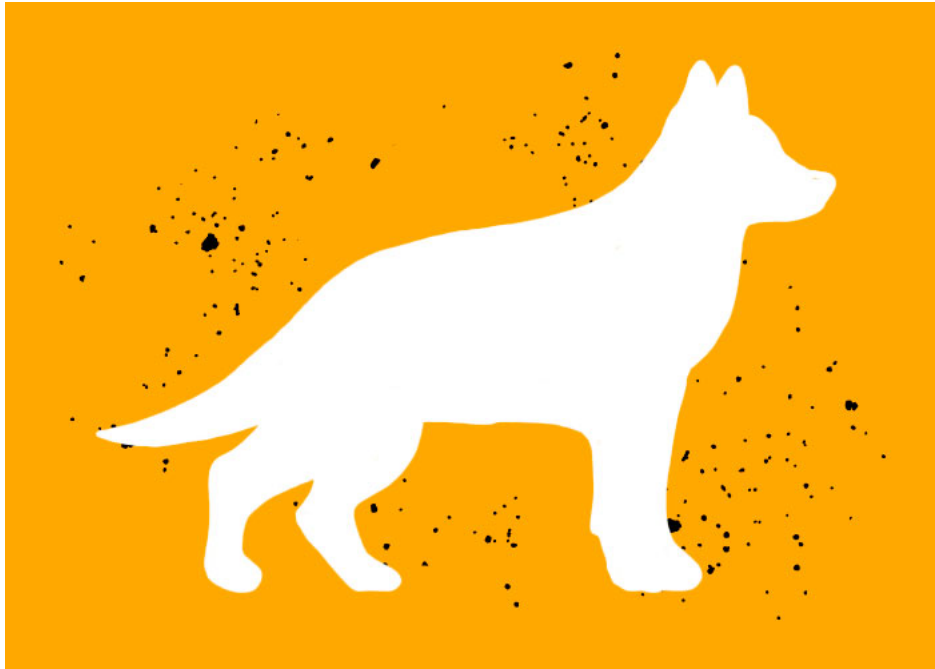
The dimensions of the **Dog L** are well suited for dogs with a max. **shoulder height of 60 cm** and a max. **length of 85 cm**. However, some larger dogs may still be able to fit easily through the door and ride comfortably in the passenger compartment. When in doubt, just give it a try! Your dog should not weigh more than 25 kg. Here are a few examples of dog breeds that would be able to ride comfortably in the Croozer Dog L:

- Airdale Terrier
- Beagle
- Bulldog
- Bull Terrier
- Chow-Chow
- Collie
- Small Münsterländer
- Pit Bull
- Siberian Husky
- Staffordshire Bullterrier
- Wolfspitz



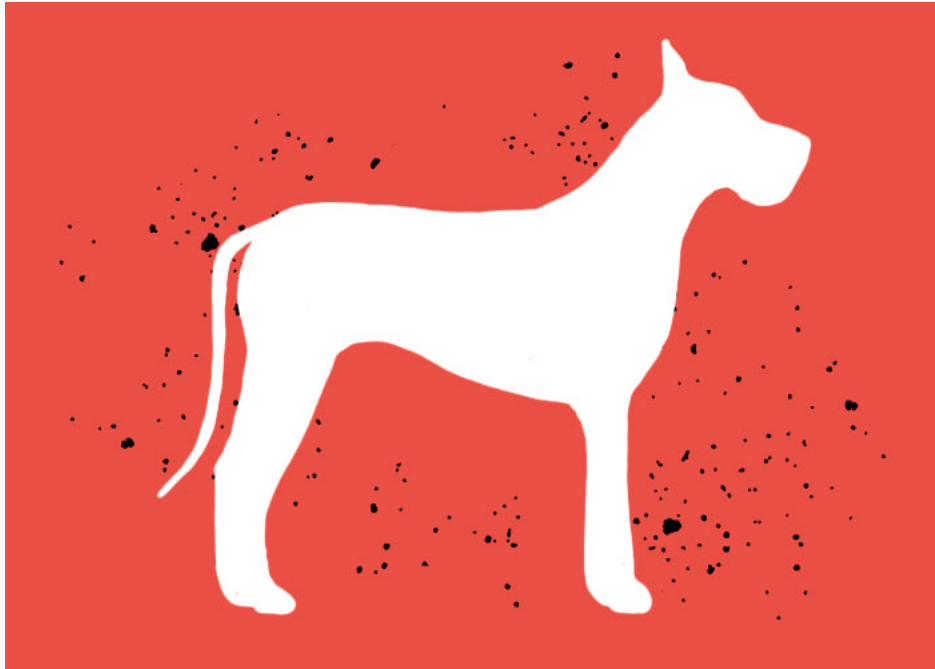
The dimensions of the **Dog XL** are well suited for dogs with a max. **shoulder height of 70 cm** and a max. **length of 100 cm**. However, some larger dogs may still be able to fit easily through the door and ride comfortably in the passenger compartment. When in doubt, just give it a try! Your dog should not weigh more than 35 kg. Here are a few examples of dog breeds that would be able to ride comfortably in the Croozer Dog XL:

- Afghan Hound
- American Staffordshire
- Berger de Brie
- Bobtail
- Bouvier des Flandres
- Boxer
- Briard
- Dalmatian
- English Setter
- Flat Coated Retriever
- German Shepherd
- Golden Retriever
- Gordon Setter
- Large Münsterländer
- Irish Red Setter
- Labrador Retriever
- Rhodesian Ridgeback
- Vizsla
- Weimaraner



The following breeds, with a shoulder height of between 55 and 82 cm (21½–32 inch) and a weight of up to 60 kg (132 lb.), are often a bit too large and heavy for the Croozer Dog XL. However, if your dog is somewhat **lighter and smaller** than average, then it might be able to enjoy riding in the Croozer. Measure your dog's height and weight to be on the safe side.

- Borzoi
- Berger de Brie
- Bernese Mountain Dog
- German Shepherd
- Doberman
- Greyhound
- Hovawart



The following dog breeds are normally too large and heavy to ride in the Croozer Dog XL. However, if your dog is **relatively small for its breed** and does not weigh more than 45 kg (99 lb.), it may be able to ride in the Dog XL.

These breeds usually have a shoulder height of between 55 and 80 cm (21½–31½ inch) and a weight of 40 to 75 kg (88–165 lb.). Therefore, most are too large for riding in the Dog XL. In case of doubt, check your dog's height and weight.
